## What I am telling people in Maine

- If government cannot tell people what the backlog is, what the staffing gap is, or whether reform changed outcomes, it is not serious enough yet.
- This platform favors public dashboards, claim-to-proof links, and recurring review over vague promises.
- The measure of reform is not rhetoric. The measure is whether pressure falls and children and families are made safer and steadier.
