To the Presiding Judge:

I am in receipt of a copy of attorney Patrick S. Bedard's Motion in Limine dated December 29, 2025. While it is accurate as stated in the Motion that I have not been appointed to serve as Guardian ad Litem for the minor child of the parties under any pending motions, I feel compelled to bring to the Court's attention the inaccuracies contained in the Motion in Limine.

Attorney Bedard's Motion states no less than four times, that I was appointed 12 or 13 years ago. That is accurate. However, the Motion fails to mention the fact that I was also appointed again on March 2018 and served for the following several months. I was appointed yet again on December 4, 2019 and served for an entire year. A review of the Court file should contain copies of my reports from my various appointments and document the extensive involvement with this family over the course of those appointments spanning several years.

In sum, my involvement with this family is lengthy and not limited to the initial appointment over a decade ago, as is implied in attorney Bedard's Motion in Limine.

I take no position on whether any testimony I might have would be admissible or relevant. I have been subpoenaed and it is my intention to appear in Court on January 16, 2026 unless directed otherwise by the Court.
